The Symposium begins at 7:00 p.m. at the Education Center, located at 6523 Duncan Road (Route 670). Take Exit 63-A off I-85, go through two stoplights, and take a left on Route 670. Go 1/2 mile and turn left at the Education Center Entrance service road. Go past the tan Operations building and curve around the circle.
