

With 424 acres, four museums, four historic homes, and miles of battlefield trails, Pamplin Historical Park & The National Museum of the Civil War Soldier has many places to explore, but not enough places to sit down. For this reason Pamplin Historical Park calls on you to dedicate a bench to provide our visitors with places for quiet reflection on the significance of our nation's past.

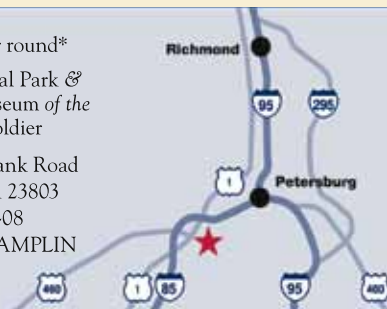
Each bench will bear a 4 x 6 engraved bronze plaque recognizing the donor and including a brief inscription of their choice. The bench is 4 feet long and made of resilient cedar-colored recycled plastic with black trim.

You may purchase a bench or plaque yourself, as a gift for someone else, or as a member of an organization. Organizations may choose to honor an individual from their current or past membership. Each purchaser will receive a Presentation Certificate suitable for framing. Those interested in holding a dedication ceremony can contact the Park for more information. All proceeds go to the purchase and installation of the bench and to the support of Pamplin Historical Park & The National Museum of the Civil War Soldier.
