Pamplin Historical Park & The National Museum of the Civil War Soldier proudly offers individuals an opportunity to honor the memory of an ancestor or any other Civil War soldier on the museum's Remembrance Wall.

Beneath the words *In Memory of Those Who Served*, the handsome maple-finished wall consists of silver-toned plaques etched in black. Each plaque includes the name and military unit of the soldier, as well as the name of the person who has purchased the plaque. Prominently located along the museum's main corridor, the Remembrance Wall is a permanent part of the museum. Tens of thousands of visitors every year see the names of the soldiers honored on the wall.

You may purchase a plaque yourself or as a gift for someone who cherishes the memory of a Civil War soldier. Each purchaser will receive a Presentation Certificate suitable for framing. All proceeds go to support Pamplin Historical Park & The National Museum of the Civil War Soldier.

If the rank and unit of the soldier to be honored is unknown, Park staff will attempt to identify that information. In cases where a donor does not have an ancestor or other specific soldier to honor, Park staff can provide the name of a soldier from the state or county of the person's choice.

- Plaques can only honor men who were regularly enlisted soldiers of the Union and Confederate armies. Sailors and civilians, even those attached to the armies, are not eligible.
- Plaques can honor only one soldier. They may not be purchased to honor military units.
- To honor more than one soldier, please copy this form, print a copy from the Park website or call the Park to request additional forms.
- The "Remembered by" portion of the plaque is restricted to the names of individuals, families or organizations purchasing the plaque or receiving it as a gift. Plaques may include Ir., Sr., III, Family, etc., but not other phrases.
- Plaques will be randomly placed on the Remembrance Wall. Pamplin Historical Park cannot accommodate requests to have a plaque placed near another plaque.
- Park staff will verify the name, rank and unit for each plaque purchased. If available documentation conflicts with information provided on this form, that documentation will be assumed accurate and will be used on the plaque.
- Pamplin Historical Park reserves the right to edit plaque information for uniformity and space limitations.
- Orders will be acknowledged with a letter and Presentation Certificate immediately prior to installation of the plaque. Due to the nature of the manufacturing process, plaques are ordered on a quarterly basis in March, June, September and December.
