This open car show is expected to draw original and restored vintage and modern vehicles and hundreds of visitors, to the historic Hart Farm located within the Park's 424-acre campus.

The Hart Farm is one of our historic homes that survived the Breakthrough Battle of April 2, 1865. Mrs. Hart and an enslaved woman took refuge in the home's cellar as it was struck by cannon fire during the fight. Emerging from the cellar, they twice stopped Federal soldiers from burning the house down. Today, the restored Hart Farm comprises over 60 acres of history and provides a great picturesque location for the car show.
